Female Parliamentarians from around the world are attending the WIP Summit 2016. It presents a unique opportunity for participants to discuss pressing global challenges and to take part in political dialogue that reflects the influence and worldwide perspectives of today's female decision-makers. This year's summit is co-hosted by the Jordanian Parliament and the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) in collaboration with the Jordanian National Commission for Women (JNCW) and Council of Women World Leaders (CWWL). It will provide a platform for the OECD MENA Transition Fund regional project "Promoting Women in Parliaments and Policy-making" annual policy dialogue.

The prestigious **WIP Certificates of Recognition** are presented at the WIP Summit 2016 to those countries, which are recognised for their political empowerment of women, and to countries that show regional leadership in closing the gender gap in politics. The awards are based on the rankings of the World Economic Forum's "Global Gender Gap Report", which are compiled in collaboration with Harvard University and the University of California, Berkeley.

The venue of the WIP Summit 2016 is **the Plenary of the Jordanian Parliament**. International Institutions such as the UN, the World Bank, the Council of Women World Leaders and the Jordanian National Council for Women (JNCW), are integral part of the WIP Summit 2016, and will provide Working Sessions.

For the first time, the Council of Women World Leaders, the network of female Presidents and Prime Ministers, will join WIP. The Council will convene its members on the occasion of the WIP Summit.
